VirtuaWin supports modules for adding functionality without adding to the size of VirtuaWin. VirtuaWin will remain as small and fast as possible but still have the ability to add features. To use a module, put the module in the 'modules' directory in your VirtuaWin installation. After the next setup dialog, the module should kick in.

The module idea is quite simple; a module consists of an ordinary windows executable that sends messages to VirtuaWin. Download the module SDK ([VirtuaWin SDK 3.1.zip](#)) to get started. Developing language supporting windows executables should be used.

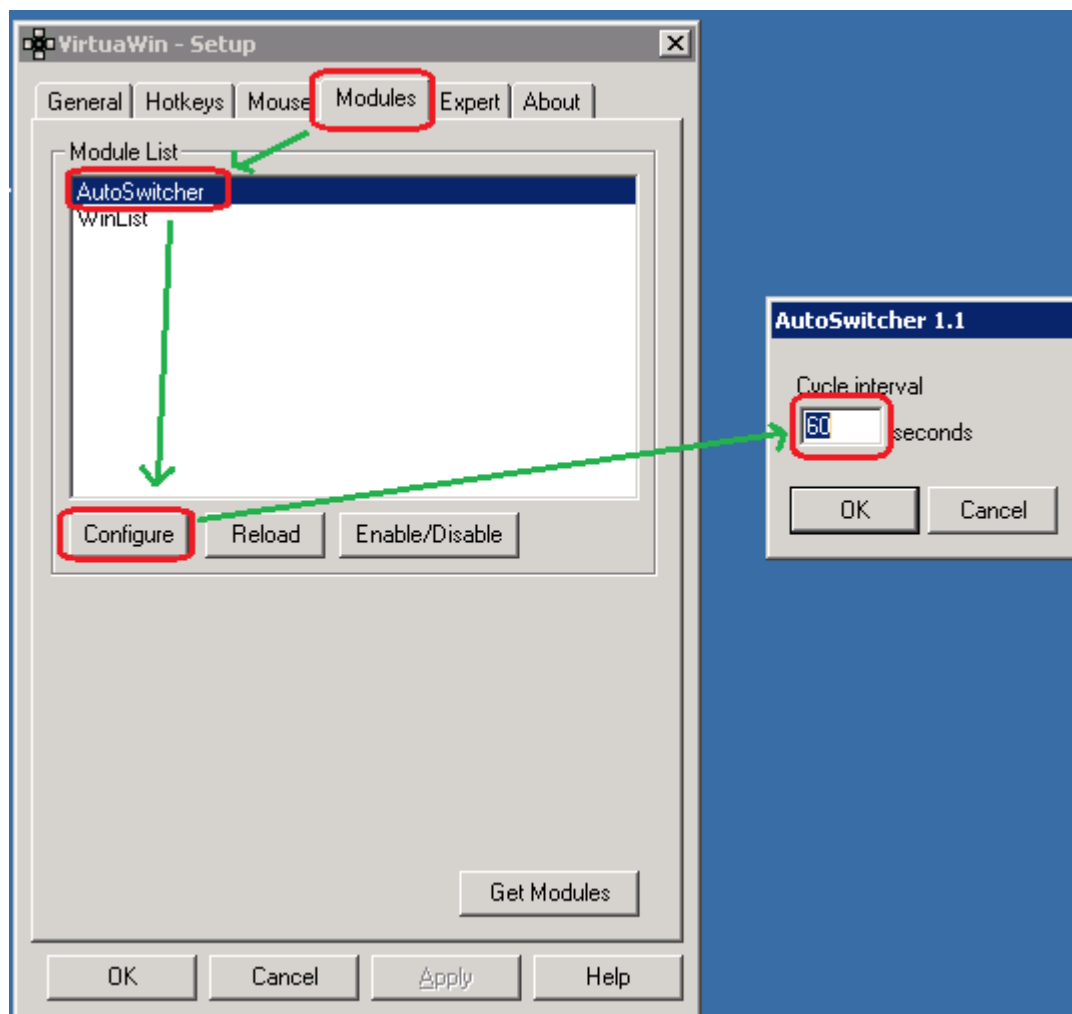
